The Fulton County Public Library formed into existence in 1903-1904, when the Women's Club of Rochester put together petitions and pushed for a library tax to provide service to the people. One result of their efforts was a beautiful new Carnegie Library at the corner of 8th and Jefferson Street in Rochester, dedicated in late 1907. Despite the difference in our present-day location, this was an outstanding foundation, and upon which the laurels of the FCPL rest to this day. We are here to provide a service, and per our mission; "It is the mission of the Fulton County Public Library to provide programs and materials to our community which promote education, culture, information and entertainment." While the mission itself has not changed in many years, the library itself and the people we serve have and will continue to change. 


