From April 5th-May 15th, an exhibit on loan from the Fort Wayne Museum of Art called *Reflections on the Civil War*, will be at the Fulton County Public Library in Rochester.

The exhibit features the work of Black & White Photographer Robert Morris who has spent several years capturing emotionally evocative images of the historic battlefields of the Civil War.

This year is the 150th anniversary of the Civil War.

Altogether the Civil War claimed more American lives than did all of the wars during the twentieth century combined.
