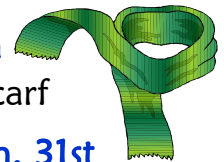

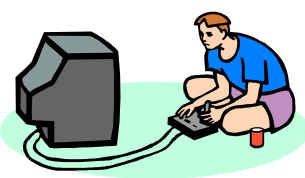

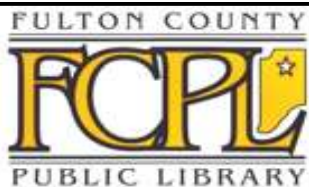


Library Recycling Day

out in early January.

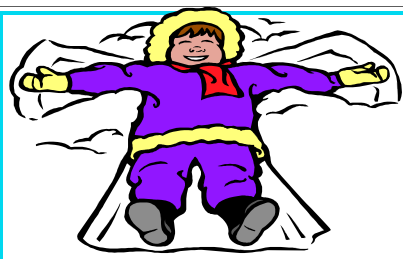

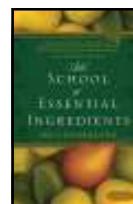
