

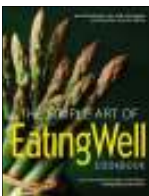

The Library will be closed on: April 5th for Staff Training & May 28th for



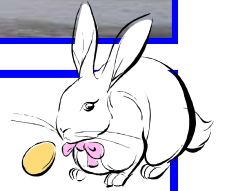
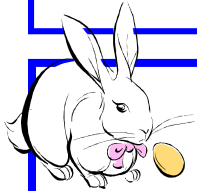
