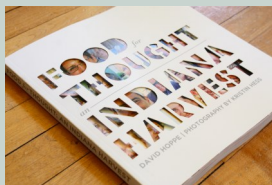
**Nov 4th** - The Dish: cook-book club. We will be looking at a cookbook on Mexican food

The Library Recyclers will be at the Recycling Center : November 23rd & 30th Come recycle with us!

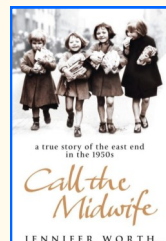

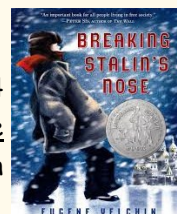

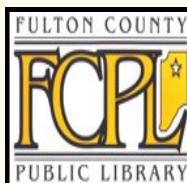
