

Information Lookup Using Library Resources

No matter what you are researching, the Fulton County Public Library has tools that can help you. The Library is a public source for all sorts of information, and we have organized things in a manner which makes finding the information you are looking for easy and fun!

Digital Resources:

Most of these require only your Library card's barcode number.

Ancestry Library Edition (available only at Library)

What it is: the largest collection of genealogical databases available online to help you find your ancestors.

What it can be used for: Finding your roots and helping to build your family tree.

ProQuest

What it is: billions of records in census data, vital records, photos, directories, etc.

What it can be used for: Finding your roots and helping to build your family tree.

AtoZ Databases

What it is: a marketing & reference database that provides details on businesses and households throughout the U.S.

What it can be used for: Finding people, Job search, Resume templates, Statistics, Genealogy, Background checks, Business listings/information

Britannica Public Library Edition

What it is: one of the most trusted encyclopedias for reference information.

What it can be used for: Sources for information for school reports/essays.

INSPIRE - Indiana's Virtual Library

What it is: a collection of academic databases and other information resources that all Indiana residents can access. Provided by the Indiana State Library.

What it can be used for: Finding resources to be used as sources for research for college essays/papers, and other such information that is typically only accessible to college students.

Auto Repair Reference Center

What it is: a do-it-yourself repair and maintenance database that contains information on most major manufactures of automobiles.

What it can be used for: Finding repair manuals for your vehicle.

Small Engine Repair Reference Center

What it is: a do-it-yourself repair and maintenance database containing information on small engines machines, such as lawnmowers, motorcycles and chainsaws.

What it can be used for: Finding repair manuals/blueprints/diagnostics manuals for non-vehicle engines/motors.

Evergreen Catalog Search

What it is: A quick way to find books, electronic media, and digital reference material available at your Library, and from other Libraries in Indiana for free.

What it can be used for: Finding a book or electronic resource, such as government e-books you can download from home or on our public computers.

Tangible Resources:

We have tangible information compendiums as well, which you can find in our electronic catalog.

Reference section

Maps, dictionaries (in many languages), and custom encyclopedias with information on every possible topic. If you can't find what you're looking for, you can also ask one of our Reference Librarians, who are well-versed in finding information.

Indiana/Genealogy area

Local historical information, old maps, and cemetery listings for most of Indiana. Also some family history books donated to the Library.

Newspapers/Digital Film archives

Local newspapers going back to the 1800's. You can print or save images to a flash drive for future reference.
