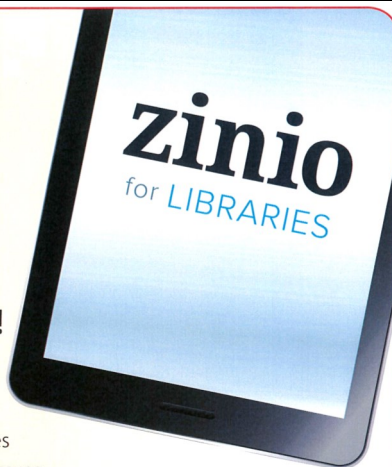
Our library is no different. We have been cleaning up our collection to put our best foot forward, new, interesting books, movies and music to borrow, and expanded electronic materials to access.
